

STUDENT PARKING LOT ENFORCEMENT TO RESUME 9/3/13

Beginning on Tuesday September 3, normal parking enforcement of all parking lots will resume. Any vehicle parked in a lot for which it does not have the proper permit may be ticketed. As always, vehicles that are improperly parked or not parked in their designated lot may be ticketed.

All vehicles parked on campus must be registered and display a valid parking permit/ hang tag to park on University property. Even if you are only taking night classes you are required to register your vehicle to park and evening parking lot enforcement will also begin on this date.

If you have not yet obtained your parking permit for the current semester, please do so before Tuesday September 3 in order to avoid any issues.
