



# University-Wide Tutorial Program:

Types of Academic Support

For courses <60 enrollment

## Peer Tutor

- Holds walk-in hours for students to come to tutoring in the tutoring center or online and is available for individual tutoring, as needed.

For large enrollment courses (>60 enrollment)

## Large Classroom Tutor (LCT)

- Holds walk-in hours for students to come to tutoring in the tutoring center or online and is available for individual tutoring, as needed.
- Assists the instructor with clerical tasks inside and outside of the class, as needed.
- Communicates with instructor for guidance and discusses challenges.

## Faculty Assistant (FA) *\*Formerly the Large Classroom Assistant (LCA) position*

- Assists the instructor with clerical tasks inside and outside of the class, as needed.
- For courses that, generally, do not require tutoring support.

For large enrollment courses (>60 enrollment) with high C-, D, F, W rates

## Learning Assistant for Supplemental Instruction (LA)

- Holds “office hours” for students to drop-in with questions about the class and is available for individual tutoring, as needed.
- Assists the instructor with clerical tasks inside and outside of the class, as needed.
- Communicates with instructor for guidance and discuss challenges.
- Holds learning (recitation) sessions outside of the class designed for review and discussion (requires formal lesson planning).
