

# Math Placement Student Communication Plan

## **Spring 2025 Incoming Students**

- Auto-loading to ALEKS as part of the 2024-2025 cohort.
- Notifications sent through Slate and kicked off by the Admissions team
- Incoming students are receiving notifications to take the ALEKS assessment once they deposit.
- Message features mandatory to test, how to access the test, link to additional information about ALEKS, due dates.
- Note: students encouraged to begin testing within 2 days of communication. Cannot be scheduled unless tested.
- Students scores are pushed to Banner through Slate. The score (type = MALK) is stored in SOATEST and is currently viewable on the Deposited Student Report (column AO), in the myESU portal (Student Information Menu→View Test Scores), and in WarriorFish (Student→Overview→Student Information).

## **Fall 2024 New Freshmen**

- Auto-loaded to ALEKS as part of the 2024-2025 cohort.
- Previously notified through Slate until the beginning of the fall 2024 semester.
- Second tier reminder and retest notification sent through WarriorFish as kicked off by Math department.
- Two cohorts of students
  - No ALEKS: have not taken the ALEKS assessment
  - Low ALEKS: have taken the ALEKS assessment but did not score high enough to place into the Math course needed for their degree program AND did not take a Math course in fall 2024.
- Initial communication for this group began in early August through end of August to help students get situated in the correct Math class for the fall 2024 semester.
- Communication will begin again during the week of 10/14/24. A strong emphasis is placed on majors whose academic program requires a Math class to complete assessment before they register. The freshmen registration start date is November 4<sup>th</sup>.
- In WarriorFish, this item is placed on students as a To-Do for intervention tracking. The To-Do triggers communication to the student, informs their academic advisor and the Records Ops team. Once students take the ALEKS, a report is sent to the Records Ops team to enter the score in Banner. The score will appear in WarriorFish and the myESU portal. When the score appears in WarriorFish, the To-Do item will be marked completed and trigger a communication to the academic advisor.

### **Continuing Students who began prior to Fall 2024**

- Manually loaded to ALEKS to be added to the 2024-2025 cohort.
- Notification sent through WarriorFish and kicked off by Math department.
- One cohort of students
  - Deficient Math Competency: have not taken or passed the hardcopy Math Competency test. Note: these students may have a MH hold (i.e., Not Demonstrated Math Competency).
- Communication will begin during the week of 10/14/24. A strong emphasis is placed on majors whose academic program requires a Math class to complete the ALEKS assessment before spring 2025 registration begins on October 31<sup>st</sup>.
- In WarriorFish, this item is placed on students as a To-Do for intervention tracking. The To-Do triggers communication to the student, informs their academic advisor and the Records Ops team. Once students take the ALEKS assessment, a report is sent to the Records Ops team to enter the score in Banner. The score will appear in WarriorFish and the myESU portal. When the score appears in WarriorFish, the To-Do item will be marked completed and trigger a communication to the academic advisor.



**Continuing Students No Math Competency Communication (initial)**

Hello STUDENT FIRST NAME,

Registration for the spring 2025 semester will begin soon. You and your academic advisor will connect to review your degree program and discuss how you will follow the courses and overall requirements for completion.
