

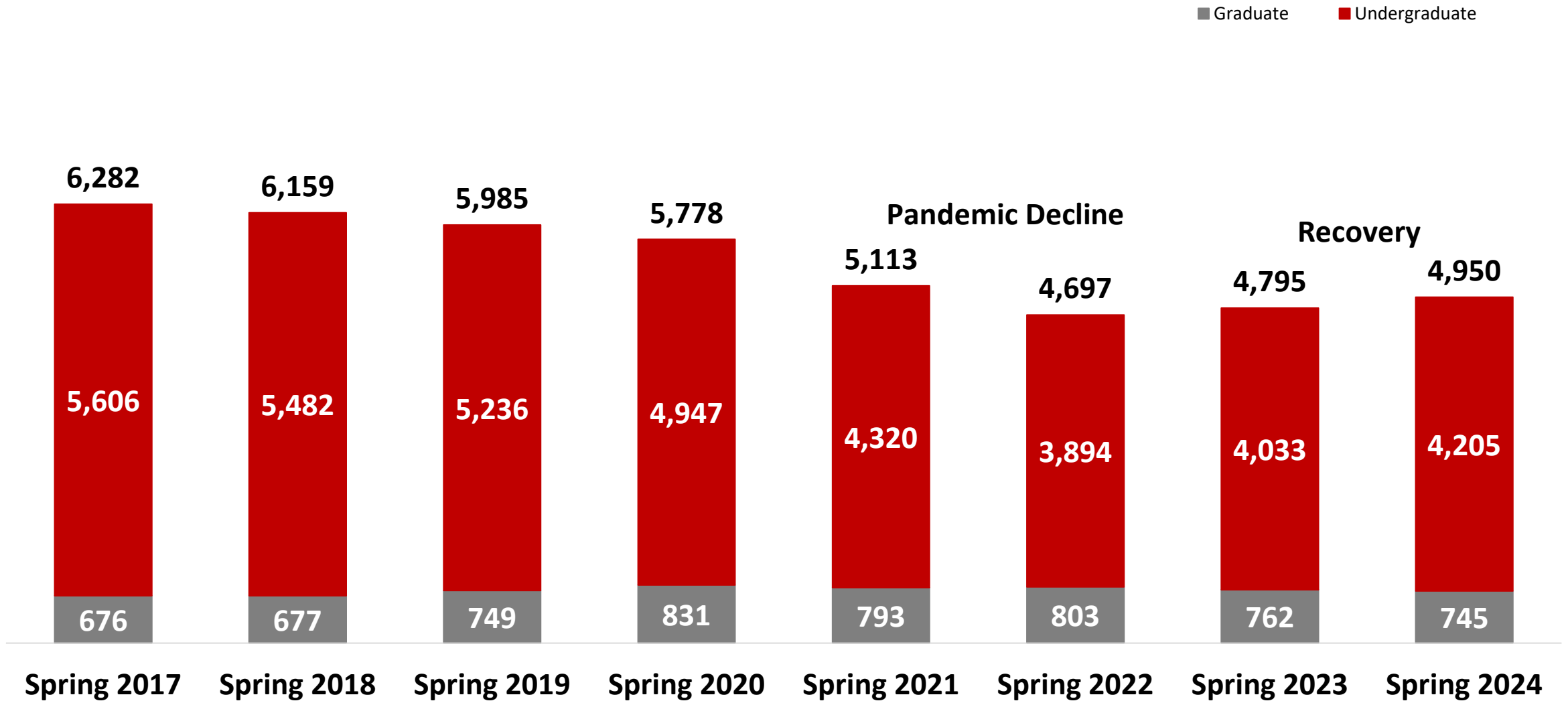

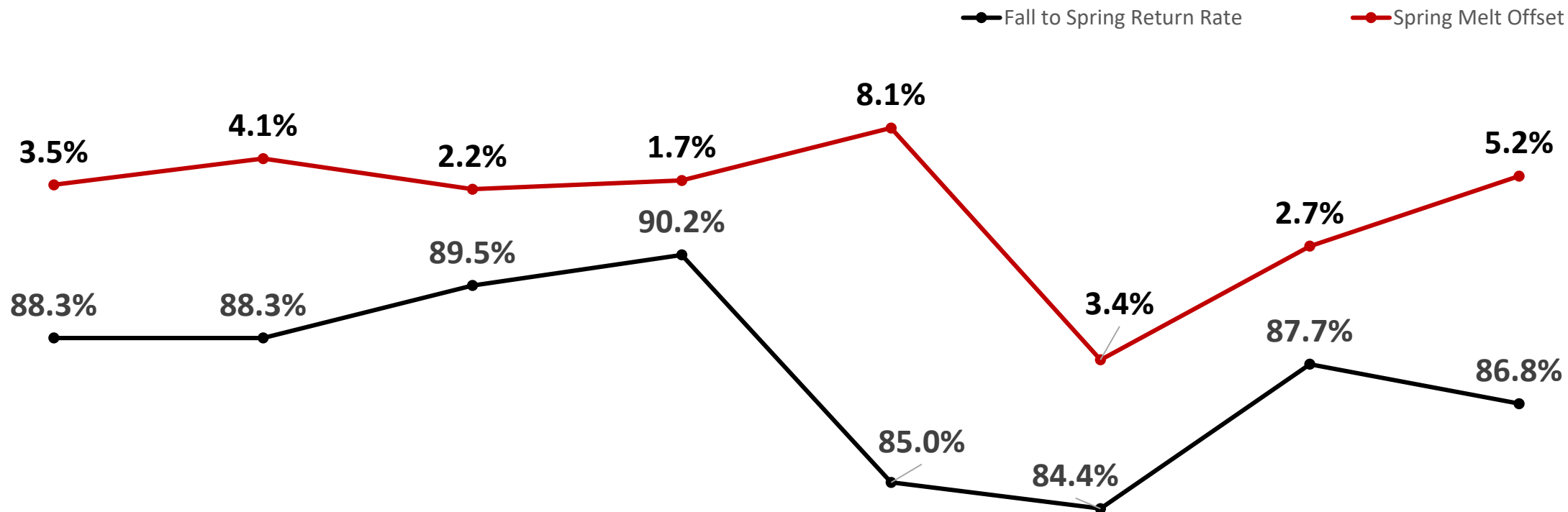

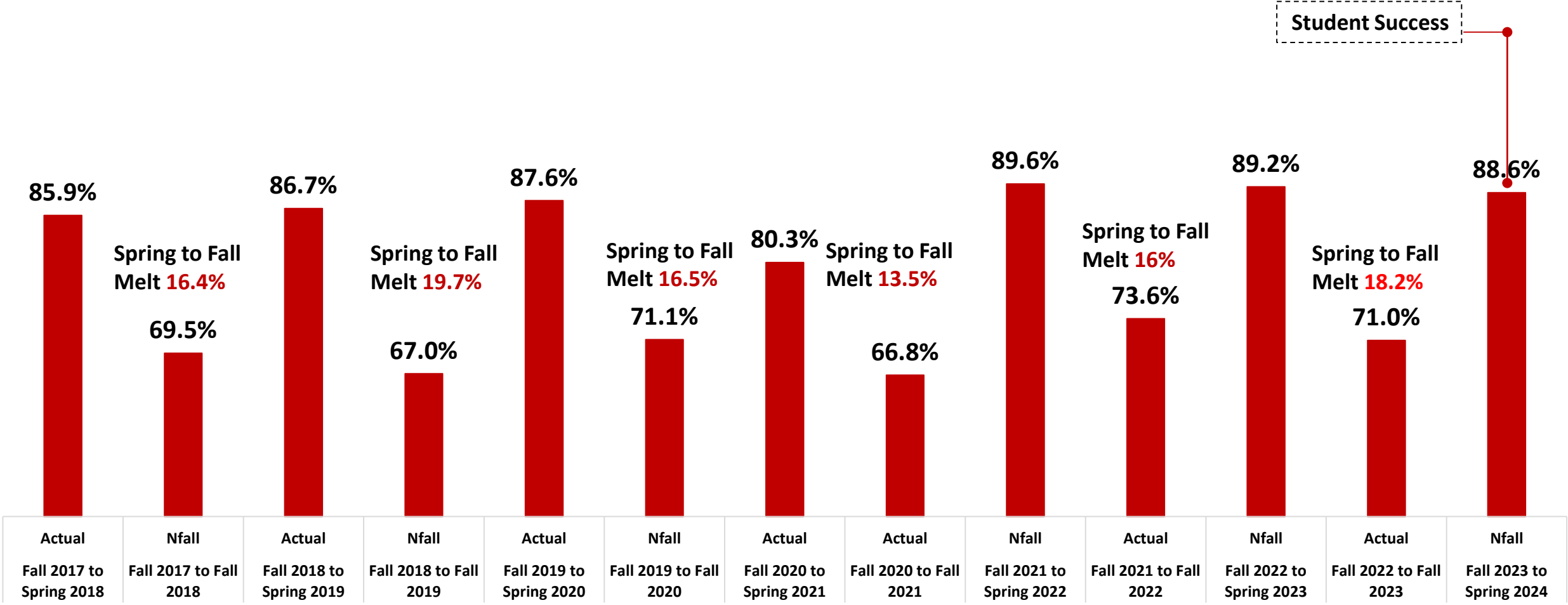

Fall to Spring Retention Rate and Fall to Fall Retention Rate



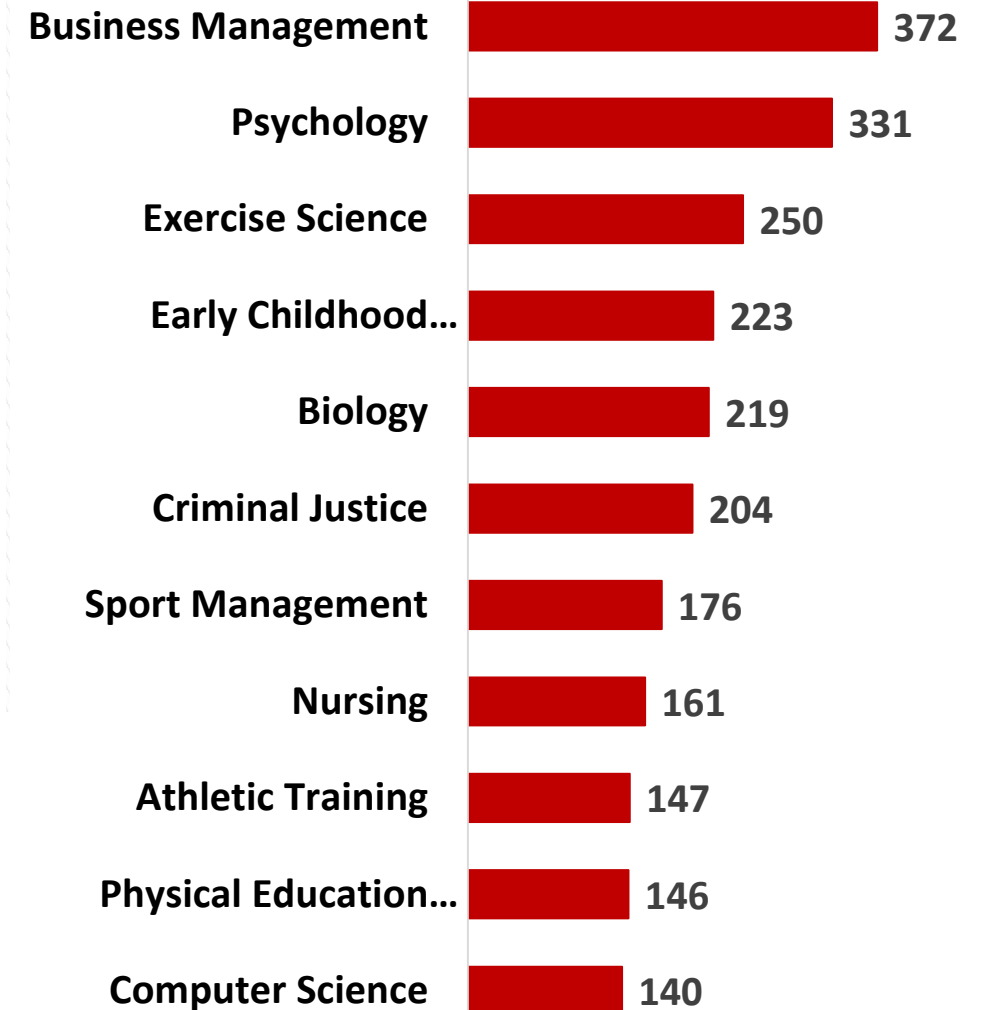

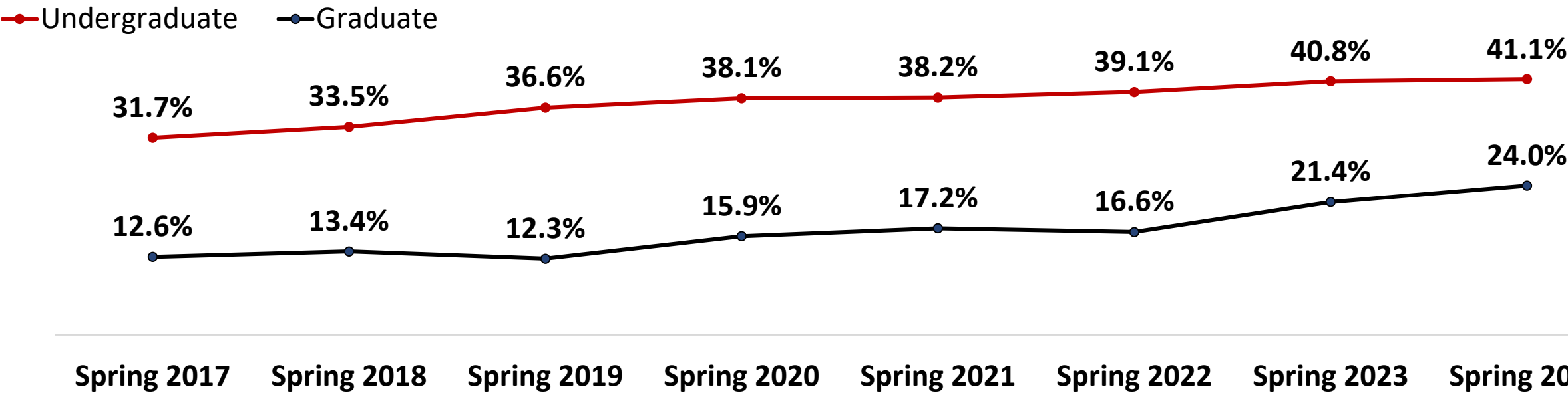
