

## George D. & Harriet D. Hall Graduate Scholarship

AREA OF STUDY: Pursuing Master's Degree in Elementary Education

SELECTED BY: The Office of Graduate Studies and Research

AMT OF AWARD: Initial award is equivalent of the cost of three instate graduate credits and fees

TIME OF AWARD: Awarded each fall for the spring semester

RENEWED: Nothing shall prevent the same student from receiving the award two or more years, but not to exceed five years, as long as all criteria continue to be satisfactorily met.

### GUIDELINES AND CRITERIA

PURPOSE: To provide scholarship assistance to a student with an undergraduate degree in elementary education who is pursuing a master's degree in elementary education.

QUALIFICATIONS: Recipient must have an employment history in the field of elementary education and a letter of recommendation from a person in a supervisory capacity attesting to the leadership qualities demonstrated by the applicant.

APPLICATION:

ACAD MERIT: Recipient must have been awarded a baccalaureate degree with certification in elementary education.

Candidates should be enrolled in at least 6 hours of graduate work during the academic year.
