Transfer Agreement

East Stroudsburg University and Lehigh Carbon Community College

East Stroudsburg University (ESU) and Lehigh Carbon Community College (LCCC) have established the following Transfer Agreement to facilitate the transfer of students from the Associate in Applied Science (AAS) Degree in Human Services at LCCC to the Bachelor of Science (BS) in Health Education - Community Health Concentration program at ESU.

Terms of Agreement: An LCCC student who has earned the AAS Degree in Human Services shall be guaranteed admission to the BS Degree in Health Education (Community Health Concentration) at ESU provided the student meets the following terms of this agreement:

- **Cumulative GPA:** Graduate from LCCC with a minimum grade point average (GPA) of 2.50.
- **Major GPA:** Graduate from LCCC with a minimum Major GPA of 3.00.
- **Transfer Credit:** ESU will accept a total of 64.5 credits from LCCC with an earned grade of 'C' or better as outlined in the Health Education (Community Health Concentration) Transfer Agreement Course Guide.
- **College Transcript:** Submit an official final LCCC transcript, indicating receipt of the AAS Degree in Human Services directly to the ESU Office of Admission prior to matriculating to ESU.
- **Enrollment:** Enroll at ESU within one year of graduation from LCCC. Not attend another institution of higher education between LCCC graduation and enrollment at ESU.
- **Applying:** Submit an application, with application fee, for admission as a transfer student to ESU. Students are encouraged to apply well before the application deadline dates. LCCC Human Services (AAS) to ESU in Health Education – Community Health (BS) Transfer Agreement Course Guide

Transfer Credits: Upon receiving an AAS in Human Services, LCCC students will be transferring a minimum of 64.5 credit hours into ESU. The following courses will transfer with a grade of "C" or better, and a 2.50 cumulative and a 3.00 major GPA. At this point, the student will be able to major in Health Education – Community Health Concentration and receive credit for the following courses:

LCCC students are encouraged to meet with their advisor or counselor to select the appropriate course(s) to fulfill major and General Education requirements at East Stroudsburg University.
**LCCC students who complete a letter of intent form to participate in this program will be given permission to substitute ENG 111 for a professional elective to meet the corequisite requirement at ESU. Letters of intent are available in the LCCC Office of Advising and Counseling or Human Services faculty/advisor.
