Transfer Agreement**

East Stroudsburg University and Community College of Philadelphia

East Stroudsburg University (ESU) Community College of Philadelphia (CCP) have established the following Transfer Agreement to facilitate the transfer of students from the Associate in Art (AA) Degree in Health Services Management at CCP to the Bachelor of Science (BS) Degree in Public Health at ESU.

Terms of Agreement: An CCP student who has earned the AA in Health Services Management shall be guaranteed admission to the Bachelor of Science Degree in Public Health at ESU provided the student meets the following terms of this agreement:

- **Cumulative GPA:** Graduate from CCP with a minimum grade point average (GPA) of 2.00.
- **Major GPA:** Graduate from CCP with a minimum Major GPA of 2.00.
- **Transfer Credit:** ESU will accept a total of 62/63 credits from CCP with an earned grade of ‘C’ or better as outlined in the Health Services Management to Public Health Agreement Course Guide.
- **College Transcript:** Submit an official final CCP transcript, indicating receipt of the AA Degree in Health Services Management directly to the ESU Office of Admission prior to matriculating to ESU.
- **Enrollment:** Enroll at ESU within one year of graduation from CCP. Not attend another institution of higher education between CCP graduation and enrollment at ESU.
- **Applying:** Submit an application, with application fee, for admission as a transfer student to ESU. Students are encouraged to apply well before the application deadline dates. Transfer Credits: Upon receiving an AA in Health Services Management, CCP students will be transferring the following 62/63 credit hours into ESU. The following courses to transfer, a grade of “C” must be earned. The transfer of grades below a “C” will be reviewed in the same manner as the grading policy of native ESU students so long as the student has earned a minimum of 60 credits from CCP with an overall GPA of 2.00. At this point, the student will be able to major in Exercise Science and receive credit for the following courses:
