Transfer Agreement

East Stroudsburg University and Sussex County Community College

East Stroudsburg University (ESU) and Sussex County Community College (SCCC) have established the following Transfer Agreement to facilitate the transfer of students from the Associate in Arts Degree in Liberal Arts Psychology at SCCC to the Bachelor of Arts in Psychology program at ESU.

Terms of Agreement: An SCCC student who has earned the AA Liberal Arts- Psychology shall be guaranteed admission to BA Degree in Psychology at ESU provided the student meets the following terms of this agreement:

- Cumulative GPA: Graduate from SCCC with a minimum grade point average (GPA) of 2.00.
- Major GPA: Graduate from SCCC with a minimum Major GPA of 2.00.
- Transfer Credit: ESU will accept a total of 65/67 credits from SCCC with an earned grade of 'C' or better as outlined in the Liberal Arts- Psychology Transfer Agreement Course Guide.
- **College Transcript:** Submit an official final SCCC transcript, indicating receipt of the AA Degree in Liberal Arts-Psychology directly to the ESU Office of Admission prior to matriculating to ESU.
- Enrollment: Enroll at ESU within one year of graduation from SCCC. Not attend another institution of higher education between SCCC graduation and enrollment at ESU.
- Applying: Submit an application, with application fee, for admission as a transfer student to ESU. Students
 are encouraged to apply well before the application deadline dates. (Please refer to the ESU Transfer Student
