

AS in Criminal Justice to BS in Criminal Justice

Transfer Agreement

East Stroudsburg University and County College of Morris

East Stroudsburg University (ESU) and County College of Morris (CCM) have established the following Transfer Agreement to facilitate the transfer of students from the AS Degree in Criminal Justice at CCM to the Bachelor of Science Degree in Criminal Justice at ESU.

Terms of Agreement: A CCM student who has earned the AS Degree in Criminal Justice shall be guaranteed admission to the BS Degree in Criminal Justice at ESU provided the student meets the following terms of this agreement:

- **Cumulative GPA:** Graduate from CCM with a minimum grade point average (GPA) of 2.00.
- **Major GPA:** Graduate from CCM with a minimum major grade point average (GPA) of 2.00.
- **Transfer Credit:** ESU will accept a total of 61-62 credits from CCM with an earned grade of 'C' or better as outlined in the Criminal Justice Transfer Agreement Course Guide.
- **College Transcript:** Submit an official final CCM transcript, indicating receipt of the AS Degree in Criminal Justice directly to the ESU Office of Admission prior to matriculating to ESU.
- **Enrollment:** Enroll at ESU within one year of graduation from CCM. Not attend another institution of higher education between CCM graduation and enrollment at ESU.
- **Applying:** Submit an application, with application fee, for admission as a transfer student to ESU. Students are encouraged to apply well before the application deadline dates. CCM in Criminal Justice (AS) to ESU in Criminal Justice (BS) Transfer Agreement Course Guide

Transfer Credits: Upon receiving an AS in Criminal Justice, CCM students will be transferring a minimum of 61-62 credit hours into ESU. The following courses will transfer with a grade of "C" or better, and a 2.00 cumulative and major GPA. At this point, the student will be able to major in Criminal Justice and receive credit for the following courses:
