

Business Administration (AS) to Finance (BS)

Transfer Agreement

East Stroudsburg University and Northampton Community College

East Stroudsburg University (ESU) and Northampton Community College (NCC) have established the following Transfer Agreement to facilitate the transfer of students from the Associate in Science Degree in Business Administration at NCC to the Bachelor of Science in Finance program at ESU.

Terms of Agreement: An NCC student who has earned the AS Degree in Business Administration shall be guaranteed admission to the BS Degree in Finance at ESU provided the student meets the following terms of this agreement:

- **Cumulative GPA:** Graduate from NCC with a minimum grade point average (GPA) of 2.50 or a 4.00 scale.
- **Major GPA:** Graduate from NCC with a minimum Major GPA of 3.00 (4.00 scale).
- **Transfer Credit:** ESU will accept a total of 64 credits from which includes 50 credits in general education/prerequisite, co-requisite and free electives, and 14 major credits, all with grades of "C" or better, as outlined in the Accounting Transfer Agreement Course Guide.
- **College Transcript:** Submit an official final NCC transcript, indicating receipt of the AAS Degree in Accounting directly to the ESU Office of Admission prior to matriculating to ESU.
- **Enrollment:** Enroll at ESU within one year of graduation from NCC. Not attend another institution of higher education between NCC graduation and enrollment at ESU.
- **Satisfy remaining pre-professional requirements** during the next available scheduled summer session at ESU; and satisfy all conditions stated in the agreement.
- **Applying:** Submit an application, with application fee, for admission as a transfer student to ESU. Students are encouraged to apply well before the application deadline dates. NCC Business Administration (AS) to ESU Finance (BS) Transfer Agreement Course Guide

Transfer Credits: Upon receiving a conferred AS degree in Business Administration with a 2.50 cumulative GPA and a 3.00 major GPA, NCC students will be transferring 64 credit hours into ESU. The following courses will transfer to ESU with a grade of "C" or better. At this point, the student will be able to major in Accounting and receive credit for the following courses:
