

RECYCLABLE MATERIALS

ACCEPTED **ALL TOGETHER** (paper, metal, plastic, and glass are *commingled*)

PAPER - Dry & Clean; loose (*not in plastic bags*)

Accepted

Newspapers & Inserts
Magazines & catalogs
Junk mail, envelopes, file folders, shredded paper
Office white, colored & computer paper (staples/clips OK)
Corrugated cardboard boxes
Cereal & gift boxes, etc. that tear brown or grey (no liners)
Paper bags
Phone books

Unacceptable

Tissue
Paper towels
Books
Tyvek envelopes
Carbon paper
Wax coated boxes/cartons (juice, milk, etc.)

METAL - Empty & Clean; loose (*not in plastic bags*)

Accepted

Aluminum cans (beer & soda)
Aluminum foil & foil plates
Metal food cans (tin/steel); metal lids
Metal pots & pans
Small metal appliances

Unacceptable

Aerosol cans
Propane tanks
Syringes
Hangers
Electrical cords

PLASTIC - Empty & Clean; loose (*not in plastic bags*)

Accepted

Plastic bottles, jars, tubs & rigid containers labeled #1-#7

Unacceptable

Unnumbered plastic containers
Plastic bags
Garden hoses

GLASS - Empty & Clean; loose (*not in plastic bags*)

Accepted

Glass bottles & jars (food & drink only)

Unacceptable

Window glass
Mirrors
Light bulbs
Glass cookware/bakeware (Pyrex, etc.)

HOUSEHOLD BATTERIES - All types (*CANNOT BE COMMINGLED WITH ABOVE ITEMS*)

Place in the container in front of Science & Technology building on Normal St.

PRINTER/COPIER TONER CARTRIDGES (*CANNOT BE COMMINGLED WITH ABOVE ITEMS*)

Bring to Office of Residence Life and Housing (Hemlock Suites)

OTHER UNACCEPTABLE MATERIALS

Food waste
Flammable, hazardous or toxic materials

Garbage

Medical waste

Paint
Ceramics, dishes, coffee cups, drinking glasses

Packing peanuts

Styrofoam
