East Stroudsburg University Commencement

Welcome to East Stroudsburg University's Commencement celebration for our graduates. Congratulations to our students who have completed their academic programs, and to their family and friends who have supported them on this journey.

Academic Procession

An usher will lead the faculty followed by the graduating students. Candidates are placed according to the degree to be conferred, and each group is preceded by a commencement marshal. Once all are seated the grand marshal leads the platform participants and the president.

Academic Attire

The tradition of academic costume began in the medieval universities of Europe where gowns were everyday dress, providing for their wearers not only distinction but, quite possibly, warmth during long hours of study in poorly heated buildings.

Today, academic attire is seen on American campuses only at formal affairs such as commencement, Founder's Day, dedications and inaugural ceremonies. In 1895, an Academic Costume Code was established, and has since been adopted by most of our colleges and universities. When the code is followed, one can identify the degree which the wearer holds, the university that awarded it, and the course of study it represents. The distinguishing features are the cut of the gown, the length and colors of the hood, and the color of the tassel on the cap.

The bachelor's and master's gowns are generally made of plain black cotton without trim, while the gown for the doctor's degree is faced with black or colored velvet and has three bars of the same material across the sleeves. The bachelor's gown has long open sleeves, the master's gown has longer closed sleeves with arm slits at the elbow, and the doctor's gown has bell-shaped sleeves extending to the wrist.

The hoods can be distinguished by both the length and color. The bachelor's hood measures three feet, the master's, three and one-half, and the doctor's, four. The color of the velvet edging, which is wider for degrees higher than the bachelor's, indicates the subject area to which the degree pertains. In addition to the colored edging, the hood shows in its lining the official color or colors of the institution which awarded the degree. The hood is worn such that a large part of the lining is visible.

The black mortarboard cap with tassel is worn with each type of gown. Those holding the doctorate wear gold tassels, while holders of the bachelor's and master's degrees generally wear a black tassel, although in recent years it has often been customary to wear the colored tassel symbolizing, like the hood, the subject area of the wearer's degree.

In nearly every academic procession, a few costumes may be seen which do not conform to the standard patterns described above. Gold braid is frequently added to the gowns of academic administrators, and most faculties include several members who hold degrees from foreign universities, some of which prescribe very colorful attire.

The following colors are associated with the various faculties. It is mandatory that they be used on hoods and optional that they be on the tassels and the velvet used with the doctor's gowns.

The Presidential Medallion

The medallion, or pectoral, has long been a symbol of the rights, authority, and power of kings and queens. At the inception of the university around the year 1000 A.D., and to this day in many European institutions, the reigning monarch still functions as the chancellor of the institution, its chief executive holding appointment as vice chancellor. With the establishment of the academy independent of the crown, the royal medallion has been retained as a symbol of the responsibilities and authority vested in the office of the president of the university by the state.



The East Stroudsburg University medallion was commissioned by the Student Activity Association in 1969, and first used by President Frank D. Sills at his inauguration. It was designed by Dr. Irene Mitchel, professor of art at East Stroudsburg University, and struck by Mr. Leslie Smith, an Allentown, Pa., craftsman. The chain of the pectoral was designed and crafted by Mr. Richard E. Phillips of East Stroudsburg, Pa.

The medallion has, on its obverse, the seal of the university. The seal is surrounded by the torch and the mace representing the light of learning and the authority of the university. These two symbols are superimposed on an abstract rendition of the Delaware Water Gap, so much a part of the geography

of the region. On either side of the seal are representations of the original Stroud Hall (1893) and the current Koehler Fieldhouse (1967). Below the seal are the extended rays representing the fourteen institutions of the Pennsylvania State System of Higher Education.

The University Mace

The mace was originally a weapon of hand-to-hand combat in medieval times. With the advent of firearms, such a weapon became archaic and was adopted to symbolize the power and authority of kings and queens. Early in the history of the academy, the mace was borrowed from royalty and utilized to symbolize the authority of the institution given to it by the kings and queens and hence, the state, to grant baccalaureate and advanced degrees so specified. The mace is used at all official university functions of an academic nature.

The original East Stroudsburg University mace was commissioned by the ESU Alumni Association for the inauguration of President Frank D. Sills in 1969. It was designed and created by Mr. Richard E. Phillips, a local Pocono artisan. The redesigned mace, incorporating many features of the original mace and symbolizing the achievement of university status by East Stroudsburg State College, was commissioned by the University Commencement Committee in 1987. Mr. Phillips was again requested to modify the mace to reflect the transition from college to university, and Cherry Valley artisan Abby Porter completed the silver work. The current mace is made of cherry and is approximately 38 inches long. The mace has overlays made of hemlock, dating from 1893 from the original Stroud Hall. The black and red coloring represents the school colors.

The octagonal head of the mace represents the disciplines of the traditional academy, and four disciplines of contemporary higher education: science, arts, humanities, and philosophy. Surrounding the head are silver hands bearing the names and dates of the five precursor institutions. The handle is inset in silver with black onyx and red carnelian. The university seal crowns the mace.



Honors and Honor Cords

Those students in the baccalaureate degree program who have received scholastic honors are distinguished by colored cords, and their names are noted in the program with the proper number of asterisks as shown below. There are three scholastic honor categories:

- * Cum Laude (white/gold cords) for those possessing a 3.400 to 3.599 quality point average
- ** Magna Cum Laude (black/gold cords) for those with a quality point average of 3.600 to 3.799
- *** Summa Cum Laude (red/gold cords) for those who have maintained a quality point average of 3.800 or above

Quality points are based on a four-point system in which the grade A equals 4, A- equals 3.667, B+ equals 3.333, B equals 3.000, B- equals 2.667, C+ equals 2.333, C equals 2, C- equals 1.667 and D equals 1.000. Honor awards are based on the cumulative average of the entire undergraduate program taken by the student at East Stroudsburg University. Honor designations are translated from Latin to mean with honor, with great honor, and with highest honor.

University Honors Program

Students wearing a red stole with "ESU Honors" on one side and the Latin "Veritas et Civitas" (meaning Truth and Citizenship) on the other are graduates of the University Honors Program. These students have completed a rigorous 15-credit Honors curriculum and written an Honors Thesis while maintaining a minimum grade point average of 3.5 in their Honors course work and 3.5 in their university studies overall. Honors Program graduates are noted with \bigstar .

Kenneth Long Interim President

Kenneth Long was appointed interim president of East Stroudsburg University of Pennsylvania by the Board of Governors for Pennsylvania's State System of Higher Education, effective July 31, 2020. Long brings more than 30 years of experience in higher education to this interim post. Prior to his appointment, Long served as the university's chief administrative, financial, and operations officer. Among his many accomplishments at ESU, he has been responsible for: stabilizing the University's financial condition; lowering cost and increasing access to healthcare by partnering with a regional medical center to provide student healthcare services; conducting the university's first academic space utilization study; upgrading athletic facilities, including adding air conditioning and a generator in Koehler Fieldhouse, painting Eiler-Martin Stadium, replacing the turf for all outdoor sports, and partnering with the local municipality and little league for baseball and softball; and coordinating the construction of a new student housing, counseling center, and testing center.

Prior to his employment at ESU, Long held positions at Kutztown and Cheyney universities. He served five years as assistant vice president of administration and finance at Kutztown University and worked six months in 2012 as interim vice president for finance and administration at Cheyney University, in a loaned executive capacity. Prior to joining the State System, Long held positions at the University of Toledo, including associate vice president for budget and planning and chief financial officer for the University of Toledo Physician Practice Group, and at DeVry University as the dean of finance and administration and director of finance of the New Jersey campus.

Long earned his bachelor's degree in math and political science from Drew University in Madison, N.J. and an M.B.A. from Monmouth University in West Long Branch, N.J. He has experience teaching college courses in business administration, financial accounting, and managerial accounting and has made presentations at numerous regional and national meetings and conferences. Long is Treasurer and Executive Board member of the Eastern Association of College and University Business Officers (EACUBO), Board member of the Pocono Mountain Music Festival, President Liaison for Pennsylvania's State System of Higher Education (PASSHE) Board of Governor's Governance Committee, and chairs PASSHE's Freedom of Speech and Title VI Task Group.

Long is married to Evelyn and has three daughters, Alysha, Peyton, and Taylor.

Susan Dillmuth-Miller, Au.D., CCC-A, FAAA, Grand Marshal University Senate President



Dr. Susan Dillmuth-Miller is an associate professor in the Department of Communication Sciences and Disorders. She is ESU's clinic audiologist and is president of the University Senate. She teaches both undergraduate and graduate courses. She has presented internationally on the effects of rheumatic disease and hearing manifestations. Scholarly endeavors include examining knowledge and attitudes of excessive noise levels and hearing protection in young adults and concussion and audiological characteristics. Andi McClanahan, Ph.D. Faculty Speaker Professor of Communication

Andi McClanahan, Ph.D. is a professor of communication and coordinator of the women and gender studies program. She became a faculty member at ESU in 2003. She earned her bachelor's degree from Bloomsburg University, a master's from Ball State University, and her doctorate from Ohio University—all in communication.

Since arriving at ESU, she has taught over 30 different courses including communication and rhetorical theory, popular culture, media criticism, and argumentation. Since 2005, she has worked in the summer for Junior State of America—a program focused on engaging youth in government. She has taught political communication and debate on the campuses of Yale, Princeton, and Stanford.

With over 25 academic publications and over 90 academic presentations, her research focuses on media representations of gender, romance, and alternative life choices—including the choice to remain single and childfree. She also actively studies the rhetoric of local and state politics. Her most recent accomplishment is the 2022 publication of the co-authored text, *Persuasion in Society* (4th edition).

Dr. McClanahan served as president of the Northeast Popular Culture Association and is currently an executive committee member and chair of their graduate student research awards. Dr. McClanahan is a nationally certified Be Body Positive facilitator through The Body Positive organization. On campus, Dr. McClanahan serves as the vice-president of ESU's Association of Pennsylvania State College and University Faculties (APSCUF). She is also the state-wide chairperson of APSCUF's Committee for Action through Politics. She is the faculty facilitator of ESU's Alumni Association Book Club. She is a member of the East Stroudsburg Borough's Planning Commission and Judge of Elections for East Stroudsburg Ward One. During the 2022-2023 academic year, Dr. McClanahan will be on sabbatical to research how breweries and wineries use neolocalism, branding, community activism, and coopetition to form the rhetoric of innovation.

Dissertation: Emergency Remote Learning: Teaching in the Time of COVID-19

Loretta A. Erdo received her Bachelor of Science degree in secondary education / English in 2001 and a Masters in Education as a reading specialist in 2006 from East Stroudsburg University. While earning her undergraduate degree, Loretta, known to her friends as Sam, worked at ESU for almost 10 years as both a custodian and secretary. She also takes much pride in her six grandchildren: Nicholas, Jacob, Alyssa, Grace, Emily, and Chase.

Dissertation Abstract: When the coronavirus pandemic forced schools to close in the spring of 2020, educators needed to move into remote teaching with very little notice. The purpose of this mixed method action research study was to identify how teachers maintained instruction during the emergency remote learning environment due to the COVID-19 school closings. Further, the study sought to determine teachers' perceptions on the successes and challenges of the remote learning process during this period.

The study was conducted in a rural northeastern Pennsylvania school district of approximately 3,000 students. Sixty-five public school teachers participated in an online survey and 13 participated in semi-structured follow-up interviews. The researcher used descriptive statistics to analyze the quantitative data and the grounded theory method to analyze the interviews. The results of the data revealed that teachers used a variety of resources and pedagogical strategies to provide engaging lessons for their students. Other findings revealed that teachers were concerned about their students' well-being and maintained frequent communication with students and parents. Results of the study indicate the importance of the following: flexibility for students, ongoing technical training for teachers, and frequent communication among students, teachers, parents, and administrators.

Dissertation: Medical Cannabis Policy in K-12 Schools: School Nurse Perspectives

Alison Jochen is a Certified School Nurse at Pleasant Valley Elementary School. Prior to becoming a school nurse, Alison worked as an emergency room nurse for 10 years. She holds a Master of Education degree that she earned from Lock Haven University of Pennsylvania in 2018. Alison received her school nurse certification in 2014 from Slippery Rock University of Pennsylvania.

She is also a graduate of the University of Delaware, where she received her Bachelor of Science in nursing in 2005. She was previously enlisted in the Army National Guard and played the trumpet in the 287th Army Band. Alison is an avid runner, having competed in cross country and track and field events at the high school and university level. Alison enjoys spending time with her family, cooking, and exploring the great outdoors. She resides in northeast Pennsylvania with her husband Michael and their three children, Kiera, Benjamin, and Zachary.

Dissertation Abstract: School nurses advocate for students who have varying medical needs, and frequently participate in development of school policies that affect student health. As states nationwide legalize cannabis for medicinal and recreational use, K-12 health policy is entangled with competing voices and conflicting stakeholder ideas. According to Kurt Lewin's Theory of Planned Change, various restraining forces may serve as barriers to the development of cannabis policy in the K-12 setting, specifically, knowledge deficits, stigma, stakeholder collegiality, federal status, and safety concerns.

To understand the influence of these restraining forces, a Likert-style questionnaire measured school nurse perceptions of these forces. Findings revealed that most districts do not have a medical cannabis administration policy regardless of state cannabis laws. Overall, the perceptions of nurses from states where cannabis is legal express significantly less concern than nurses from illegal and medical only states for the restraining forces of safety, stigma, and federal status. Conditions identified by nurses as warranting appropriate for medical cannabis included seizures, pain, psychiatric conditions, and cancer. Implications for practice include continuing the discussion of medical cannabis policy, collaboration with stakeholders, educating those involved at the forefront, and reclassification of cannabis from a Schedule 1 substance.

Alicia A. Knauff B.A., Cedar Crest College, 2001 M.Ed., DeSales University, 2007

Dissertation: Uncovering the Hidden Voices Between the Walls of a Suburban Public High School Through Participatory Action Research

Alicia Knauff is an assistant principal at her alma mater, Whitehall High School in Whitehall, Pa., where she is life-long resident. After graduating from Cedar Crest College in 2001, she began her teaching career in the Allentown School District. After earning her master's degree in TESOL from

DeSales University, she began in the Whitehall-Coplay School District in 2006 and later earned her principal certification from Cabrini University before beginning the doctoral program at ESU. Most importantly, she is the proud mother of three girls – Shadimon, Amaya and Jade.

Dissertation Abstract: Highlighting the importance of student voice, this participatory action research study uncovers the perceptions, truths, and first-hand experiences of Black and Brown students in their public high school. The increase in national attention to racial inequities in America, and more specifically, within the field of education highlights the systematic racial inequities that deny Black and Brown students of the same educational experience as their White peers. The sample size included 10 students of color who attend a suburban high school with primarily white faculty and staff. Data was collected through one-on-one interviews and focus groups.

Analysis of the data employed critical race discourse analysis methods to determine themes in the perceptions of Black and Brown students who experience our educational system on a daily basis. The findings indicate Black and Brown students are yearning to be heard. All of the participants stated they feel their voice isn't acknowledged and that they aren't truly understood by their white counterparts nor school personnel. Through the lens of critical race theory, the researcher gained insight from the voices of historically marginalized students that may inform change efforts designed to reduce inequity and build a safe, supportive school culture.

Dissertation Abstract: Typical treatment modalities for obesity are often difficult to adhere to long-term. This has revealed a need for alternative dietary control methods that are easily understood and implemented. Previous studies have demonstrated that restricting dietary intake to an eight-hour period each day followed by a 16-hour fast often results in loss of body weight and improvement in biochemical parameters in the absence of calorie or food restriction. A longer eating window may prove to be more sustainable. In this six-week study, overweight women (n=21) age 40+ were randomly assigned to a 10-hour early time restricted eating pattern that started before 8:00 a.m., a delayed 10-hour time restricted eating pattern that started after 11:00 a.m., or a control group.

At the end of the six-week period, there were clinically significant changes in muscle mass, waist circumference, fasting blood glucose, systolic blood pressure (BP), and diastolic BP in both time restricted groups compared to the control. From pre- to post-testing, those in the early time restricted eating group demonstrated statistically significant changes in waist circumference (p=.035), fasting blood glucose (p=.013), and HDL-Cholesterol (p=.018) with clinically relevant trends in muscle mass, HDL cholesterol, systolic blood pressure, and diastolic blood pressure. In the delayed eating group, there were clinically relevant trends pre- to post-testing for weight, waist circumference, fasting blood glucose, total cholesterol, HDL cholesterol, LDL cholesterol, systolic blood pressure, and diastolic blood pressure. These findings may demonstrate that 10-hour time restricted eating effectively improves health outcomes regardless of the time of day being implemented.

Dissertation Abstract:

Introduction:

The purpose of this study is to assess the level of burnout, rank stressors, and identify coping strategies among heath administrators during the COVID-19 pandemic. Several studies have been conducted on levels of burnout among frontline workers; however, there is a literature gap on burnout within health administrators.

Methods:

This is a cross-sectional mixed methods study. The survey was conducted between July and October 2021. Quantitative data was collected using the Maslach Burnout Inventory-General Survey (MBI-GS), two questions on the level of burnout, and a list of stressors. Qualitative data was collected with four open-ended questions. Quantitative data were analyzed through descriptive and inferential statistical techniques. Qualitative data was coded to derive major and minor themes.

Results:

A total of 68 (a return rate of 16%) were submitted. Results showed that 64.2% administrators are experiencing burnout. The pandemic was considered a contributor of burnout with 61% of the participants agreeing. There was no significance between the years in the position and the level of burnout. Analysis of the MBI-GS survey showed that on average all workers sometimes experienced exhaustion, while senior and frontline leaders sometimes experienced cynicism, and all respondents often felt positive about their professional efficacy. The three top stressors were staff, safety, and facility resources. Coping strategies were management, leadership, organizational, and communication/listening.

Discussion:

Health administrators have experienced some level of burnout. Coping mechanisms employed during this time appear to have contributed to the low levels of exhaustion and cynicism, and high levels of professional efficiency.
