2008-2016 A program that provides transition activities and information for students and for the parents of students entering Kindergarten. As the original creator, I created materials, PPTs, schedules and worked with administrators on staffing, use of facilities, professional development for faculty and staff. As coordinator, I have collected data and created spreadsheets that document student pre and post test results. Continued monitoring of student achievement as determined by DIBELS data has shown that students who attend this program equal or out distance the district average.

2010-2014 This program was designed to encourage parents to participate in at home educational activities in Early Literacy, Math, Science, Technology and Kidwriting. Sessions were held at six elementary schools in our school district.

**STEAM-R at Smithfield Elem.**

2016 This Summer Program focuses on Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, Math and Reading. My responsibilities included: the development of the program, staffing, budgeting, daily teaching and coordination. I have created course evaluations, creative challenges, PPTs, for use during and upon completion of this program.
