


Map of East Stroudsburg University





** Study site was split into four quadrants. Maps generally depict where preferred habitat is located or where specific species have been seen more than once even if not in preferred habitat. Grassland (G) habitat also includes forest/open area ecotones. Aerial (A) describes species likely to be seen flying overhead in addition to their preferred habitat.

*** Accidental species were reported only one time within the study site and are not typical of this area.
