
#### Analysis of Student Survey Comments from National Survey of Student Engagement 2008

The National Survey of Student Engagement (NSSE) is a national student survey that assesses the extent to which first year and senior students engage in educational practices associated with high levels of learning as determined by decades of research. NSSE asks students to report on their behaviors in college, their perception of the institution's actions and priorities, and their overall reactions to college. ESU administered NSSE for the first time during the Spring 2008 semester. The survey response rate for first-year students was 34% (376 of 1,118) and the response rate for seniors was 30% (294 of 967). Students who completed the survey were invited to add comments. Seventy-nine of the survey respondents chose to write in comments, 34 first-year and 45 senior students. A summary analysis of the provided comments is found below. Seniors reported more positive experiences than first-year students in the categories of Experience at ESU (Overall) and Faculty; however, they reported more negative experiences regarding Parking and Academic Advisors than the first-year students. There are no apparent differences in the responses between first-year and senior students for the other categories.

# **Experience at ESU (Overall)**
