

Room Selection begins March 23, and here are a few things to keep in mind:

You must be registered for classes by the end of the spring semester in order to keep your room assignment.

SCHEDULE - CREDITS EARNED AS OF DECEMBER, 2025 (the classes you are taking now do not count as credits earned):

March 23 & 24: SAME ROOM Days (for singles as well)

March 25: Administrative Rest Day – No Room Selection

March 26 & 27: You have earned more than 44 credits

March 30 & 31: You have earned 22-43 Credits

April 1, 2, & 3: You have earned 12-21 Credits

April 6 - 10: You have earned 11 credits or less

On Same Room Days, you may select a single room by yourself, or with roommates/suite-mates/apartment-mates. If you choose roommates/suite-mates/apartment-mates, make sure you have spoken with your current roommate to ensure that they can stay in the same room if they want to. Failure to do so could result in you being moved.

HIGHLIGHTS THIS YEAR:

ALL of Sycamore, Hawthorn Floors 1, 2, and 3, and Lenape Floors 2, 3, and 4 will be reserved for the incoming class of freshman. You may select another suite according to the credits you have earned.

“Super Singles” will be available again in Minsi Hall. They are double sized rooms, with a full bed, and you are guaranteed to be by yourself. **However, Minsi Hall cannot accommodate air conditioning for Fall 2026, including window units approved by OASIS.**

Quad Suites are both very uncommon and very popular. Last year, they were gone halfway through the third day of Room Selection. If you have a group of four and want single rooms, we highly recommend University Ridge.

Please note that as soon as your credits earned process date starts, you may select anytime on that day or later, until the process closes on April 10. The longer you wait, the fewer options there will be.

TO SELECT A ROOM:

Log back into your portal, and follow the housing application link to access Room Selection, a drop down box at the top. The system will show you only what rooms are available based upon the roommate group you have identified. Changes in Room/Suite/Apartment-mates can be made at any time during the Room Selection process.
