In Pennsylvania, the Principal certificate covers all grades K-12. As a result, the required courses build competencies across the elementary and secondary education spectrum. In addition to completing the required courses, the Pennsylvania Department of Education requires principal certification candidates to have a minimum of 3 years of relevant instructional experience, pass the appropriate PRAXIS test, and maintain a 3.00 GPA in their program.

Principal certification candidates with prior graduate level coursework should consult their advisor to determine whether that coursework satisfies the competencies for specific ESU courses in the Educational Leadership track. Students wishing to earn a M.Ed. in conjunction with the Principal certification must complete PSED 510 and 516.
