Incident Details:	At approximately 3:40pm on Tuesday, March 4, 2025 Officer Jamie JONES conducted a patrol of Sycamore Suites. This Officer noticed the odor of burning cannabis upon entering the main lobby of Sycamore Suites. This Officer continued to walk through the first floor of the building to locate the source and noticed the odor was strongest near the main lounge. This Officer entered the main lounge (Sycamore Suites #142) at approximately 3:45pm and observed one individual sitting near the fireplace. There was an overwhelming odor of burnt cannabis as this Officer got closer to the fireplace. This individual was wearing a green sweater and was holding a rolled joint in their left hand. This Officer introduced herself and asked to see the ID cards for the
	individual. This individual name was "Billy" and asked why this Officer was "wrecking the vibes for their day". The student provided their ESU e-Card identifying them as William WARRIOR. During discussion this Officer noticed that the student showed physical signs of cannabis use including bloodshot eyes and a lack of concentration.
