

Chapter 30:

General Information:

This entitlement is only for Active Duty member or prior Active Duty members. The Chapter 30 benefits run out after 10 years from the date of Discharge. The duration of this benefit is 1 month of Active Duty that the student has served up to 36 months accrued. This benefit is offered to any service member that has served Active Duty past the year of July 1st, 1985. Soldier must have at least 3 or 2 years of continuous Active Duty. Soldier must also have a GED or High School Diploma and have participated in the contribution of \$100 per month for the first 12 months of his/her contract.

Benefits:

Student with at least 3 years of service compared to the amount of class they are taking

Students with less than 3 years of service compared to the amount of class they are taking

Credits Taken	Entitlement
12 or more Credits	\$1,158

Extra Information:

Students will still be responsible for paying fees, costs of Books, tuition that is over the allotted amount, and other financial fees associated with attending college. Chapter 30 will only help pay for tuition.
