

**9/11 GI Bill:** The Department of Veterans Affairs offers up to 36 months of benefits for at least 36 months on active duty served. A percentage of the Maximum benefit is payable for the periods of duty for less than 36 months. Student will receive the BAH rate of an E-5 with dependents. The current rate of BAH for ESU is \$1,365, in which the eligible person is entitled to per month time's percentage of entitlement. The Veterans Affairs changed for classes that start pass August 1st, of 2011 with a rate of pursuit. To calculate how much the student is entitled for with the following formula. BAH times Percentage of Benefit time's rate of pursuit. 12 credits per semester are considered 100% of a rate of pursuit. The student is also entitled to a \$1000 yearly stipend for books and supplies at 100% tier level.

At least 36 months of Active duty	100%
At least 30 months, but less than 36	90%
At least 24 months, but less than 30	80%
At least 18 months, but less than 24	70%
At least 12 months, but less than 18	60%
At least 6 months, but less than 12	50%
At least 90 days, but less than 6 months	40%
