## Improving Word Choice

Effective word choice will be specific and should create a mental picture of what they are trying to say to their reader.

| Example "Garbage" Words | Alternative words to use |
| :---: | :---: |
| A lot | Plenty, much, an abundance |
| Good | Quality, upstanding, enjoyable, kind |
| Bad | Poor, unacceptable, harmful, evil |
| Said | Stated, voiced, repeated, presumed |
| Nice | Likable, personable, delightful |
| Stuff | Materials, information |
| Something | Add a noun after "something" <br> Example: something white, something scary |
| This | Add a noun after "this" <br> Example: this argument, this story |
| That | Add a noun after "that" Example: that elephant, that girl |
| Etc. | And so on, and so forth, among others |
| Things | Items, artifacts, object, belongings |
